After this class, a free **Community Support Group** also meets at 9:30 a.m. on the same day.

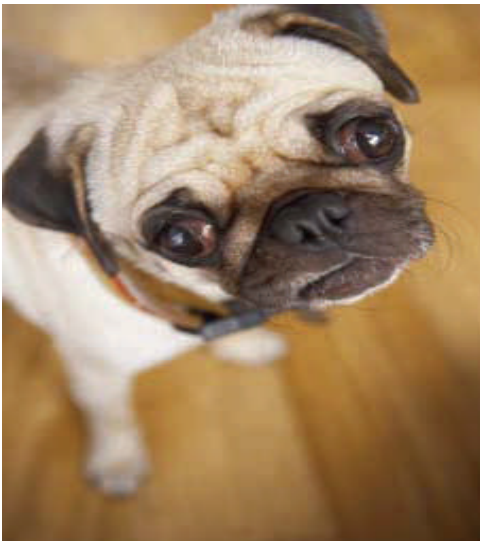
Prerequisite: You must first attend a Pet Loss Class. After attending [1] class, you may attend to support group for as many times as needed.
